Section 1. The City Council hereby approves the proposed revisions to the Building and Planning fee schedule.



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A. GENERAL INFORMATION ON SPECIAL FEES, REFUNDS, EXTENSIONS, RENEWALS, AND CANCELLATIONS.

I. DOUBLE FEES

BD200

When work for which a permit is required is commenced prior to obtaining a permit, the permit applicant will be required to pay one hundred dollars (\$100.00¹) plus a double permit fee. The payment of the required fee shall not relieve them from being subject to any of the penalties therein. The double fee requirements shall be applicable to all divisions of the Building Department as noted herein.

BD210

For second offense of doing work without a permit, the permit applicant shall be required to pay twice the double permit fees plus two hundred dollars (\$200.00).

BD220

For each offense thereafter, the permit applicant shall be required to pay twice the double permit fee plus five hundred dollars (\$500.00).

2. RE-INSPECTION FEES

BD230

A permit holder shall be entitled to an initial inspection provided the inspector can conduct the inspection. All work shall be inspected and the building inspector shall note deficiencies. When the work to be inspected is only partially complete, the inspection shall be performed on those portions of the work completed, provided that compliance with the Florida Building Code may be determined with respect to those portions. A permit holder may pay a fee of \$60.00 for each additional inspection required assuring compliance with the Florida Building Code beyond the initial inspection. All additional inspection fees shall be paid prior to the next inspection and shall be paid at the City of Doral Building Department.

3. LOST, REVISED AND REWORKED PLANS FEES

BD801 Res. BD802 Comm.

(a) LOST PLANS: When plans for new buildings and additions are lost by the owner/agent or contractor, a re-certification fee will be required to review, stamp and approve a new set of plans as authentic. Such fee shall be based on 30% of the original building permit fee plus the cost of duplication with minimum fees of:

Minimum for Group R3 (Single Family/Duplex) \$86.00 Minimum fee for all others \$160.00 Documents only, all trades (no plans) 30% base fee no minimum

As per Code of Miami-Dade County Chapter 8 Section 8-12(c).

(b) REVISED PLANS PROCESSING FEE

BD500

(1) Major plan revision after permit is issued shall be subject to a fee of 50% of the original permit fee up to a maximum of \$1,800.00.

BD501

(2) Minor plan revisions shall be subject to a fee at the rate of \$86.00 for each review that takes longer the 5 minutes. If all pertinent reviews take less than 5 minutes there will be no charge.

BD803

(c) **REWORKS**: A fee of \$85.00 may be charged for failure to make required corrections previously indicated.

BD804

(d) LOST PERMIT CARD FEE: A replacement fee of \$40.00 shall be charged for the loss of a Permit Card after a permit has been issued.

(e) RECORDS OF INSPECTIONS RESULTS

.....See Section H "Cost of Records"

4. REFUNDS, TIME LIMITATIONS, CANCELLATIONS AND RENEWALS

The fees charged pursuant to this schedule, provided the same are for a permit required by Section 104.1.1 of the Florida Building Code and Chapter 8 of Code of Miami-Dade County, may be refunded by the Building Official subject to the following:

- (a) No refunds shall be made on requests involving:
 - (1) Permit fees of \$100.00 or less; or
 - (2) Permits revoked by the Building Official under authority granted by the Florida Building Code and Chapter 8 of Code of Miami-Dade County, or permits cancelled by court order, or conditional permits; or
 - (3) Permits which have expired; or
 - (4) Permits under which work has commenced as evidenced by any recorded inspection having been made by the Department; or
 - (5) The original permit holder when there is a change of contractor.

(b) A full refund less than \$100.00 or 50% of the permit fee, whichever is greater, rounded to the nearest dollar, shall be granted to a permit holder who:

Requests a refund, provided:

- (1) That the Building Department receives a written request from the permit holder prior to the permit expiration date; and
- (2) That the permit holder submits with such request the applicant's validated copy of such permit; and
- (3) That no work has commenced under such permit as evidenced by any recorded inspection and/or field inspection.

BD540

(c) Where there is a **change of contractor** or qualifier involving a permit, the second permit holder shall pay a fee of \$140.00.

BD510

(d) A fee of the "original permit fee" or maximum of \$125.00 shall be paid by the permit holder who submits a written request for a **permit extension** as authorized under Section 104.1.6 Florida Building Code.

BD520

(e) Where a permit has become null and void pursuant to paragraph 104.5 Florida Building Code, a credit of fifty percent (50%) of the permit fee shall be applied to any re-application (Renewal) fee for a permit covering the same project and involving the same plans, provided that the complete reapplication is made within six (6) months of the expiration date of the original permit, and provided that no refund had been made as provided in this Section.

Other agencies including, but not limited to, the Department of Environmental Resources Management, Building Code Compliance Office and the Florida Department of Health assess fees on building permits, including re-application on expired permits (contact the applicable agencies for details).

5. SPECIAL PROJECTS

BD560

A fee equal to actual staff time and related costs shall be assessed for special projects requiring research by the Department in order to answer questions proposed by developers, attorneys, realtors, or municipalities, etc., in connection with the use, re-subdivision, and development of properties, or to determine if any existing violations are on the property through a review of departmental records. Such

special fee will only be levied for requests outside the scope of normal departmental work. A minimum fee of \$60.00 will be charged. A fee equal to \$2.00 per page shall be assessed for pre-programmed computer reports on Department records.

6. GENERAL INFORMATION

BD600

(a) A \$0.01 per square foot fee will be added to building permits for the State of Florida to study building code requirements for **radon gas**, and certification and regulation of building code administrators, plan examiners and inspectors.

BD700

- **(b)** A fee of six (6%) percent (for **concurrency review**) of the total permit fee will be added to original fees where a concurrency review was performed.
- (c) Road, School, and Fire Impact fees are assessed on certain building permits, including re-application on expired permits (contact the Miami-Dade County Impact Fee Section for details on these fees).

BD300

- (d) Miami-Dade County Code Compliance fee of \$0.60 per \$1,000.00 of estimated construction valuation.
 - ➤ Groups F & S use \$45.00 per sq.ft. for valuation.
 - All other groups use \$65.00 per sq.ft. for valuation.

BD600

- (e) A City of Doral Parks and Recreation Impact Fee of \$1453.40 and a Police Impact Fee of \$101.29 shall be applied to each unit of a new construction single family, duplex and multi-family buildings.
- **(f)** A **Scanning Fee** of \$3.00 per page will be accessed on all documents presented for permitting. Including revisions, shop drawings, etc.

8. INSPECTIONS REQUIRING OVERTIME

Charges for construction inspections, which are requested in advance and which require that an employee work overtime, will be at a rate of \$75.00 per hour and in accordance with applicable employee contracted bargaining agreements.

9. FEES BASED ON ESTIMATED COST (DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENTS)

The Building Division may require the permit applicant to submit appropriate documentation as proof of estimated cost of construction used to compute permit fees.

10. ACTUAL COST FOR PROJECTS REQUIRING SERVICES NOT CONTEMPLATED IN CURRENT FEE STRUCTURE

The Director, or designee, has the authority to invoice for reimbursement of actual costs on projects requiring services not contemplated in the current fee structure.

The invoice will consist of actual labor cost, including any and all fringe benefit costs the Department is legally obligated to pay. Additionally, the invoice will include any other indirect cost associated with the actual labor cost, as determined by the City of Doral Building Department on a yearly basis.

All projects will have mutually agreed on contract(s), which will be maintained in the Department. The director will also have the ability to request a deposit amount that is mutually acceptable to the Department and the company or individual that is legally responsible for the project(s). The deposit amount shall be used to offset the final invoiced project cost; if any amount is remaining, it shall be returned to the party that executed the agreement with the Department. The life span of the project(s) shall be included in the agreement.

II.CERTIFICATES OF OCCUPANCY AND COMPLETION

Fees for Certificates of Occupancy and Certificate of Completion issued by the Building Department will be assessed in accordance with section 'C' herein.
