#### **RESOLUTION No. 14-68**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE CITY'S INVOLVEMENT IN THE FOOD SERVICE PROGRAM; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on April 14, 2014, the City of Doral (the "City"), by and through the Parks and Recreation Department, applied for the Summer Food Service Program, a federally funded and state executed, nine-week food service program for children, with the City seeking assistance for the children attending the 2014 City Summer Camps held at Morgan Levy Park (the "SFSP"); and

WHEREAS, the SFSP is administered by the Village Youth Services, Inc., a non-profit responsible for overseeing delivery of food to the City's designated feeding site at Morgan Levy Park.

WHEREAS, on or about April 16, 2014, the City was advised by Village Youth Services, Inc. that the City's application to participate in the SFSP had been approved, resulting in the provision of daily free lunches and snacks for approximately one hundred (100) children at Morgan Levy Park; and

WHEREAS, participation in the SFSP has no direct cost to the City, except for the limited costs of personnel needed to implement, monitor and manage the City's involvement in the SFSP; and

**WHERES,** staff has recommended approval of the City's participation in the SFSP; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council desire for the City to participate in the SFSP and to offer the families of children who participate in the City Summer Camps at Morgan Levy Park the opportunity to obtain a free, nutritious lunch for their children and to

generally provide a new incentive to participating in the City Summer Camps at Morgan Levy.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Recitals.</u> The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference.

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Approval.</u> The City's involvement in the Summer Food Service Program, pursuant to the City's Application, which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", is approved.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Implementation.</u> The City Manager is authorized to execute any documents related to the SFSP, to direct staff to assist in the implementation of the SFSP, and to take such other action, as may be necessary to accomplish the objectives of this Resolution.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
