RESOLUTION NO. 14-26

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF DORAL, FLORIDA PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-322 OF THE CITY CODE, ADOPTING THE EXISTING AGREEMENT BETWEEN SIGNAL TECHNOLOGIES ENTERPRISES, INC. AND THE CITY OF MIAMI, WHICH WAS COMPETITIVELY ENTERED INTO IN A MANNER SIMILAR TO THAT SET FORTH IN CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE V, OF THE CITY CODE, FOR THE INSTALLATION OF LIGHTS, SIRENS AND OTHER EQUIPMENT ON 14 NEW POLICE VEHICLES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$55,566.00; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY WITH RESPECT TO THE AGREEMENT APPROVED HEREIN; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (POLICE)

WHEREAS, ITB #2013-24 was issued on November 6, 2013 for the purchase and installation of Emergency Equipment. Two (2) Bids were received and opened on December 11, 2013, with one (1) company meeting the required criteria. Signal Technology Enterprises, Inc. was deemed the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

WHEREAS, the City of Doral Police Department seeks to install sirens, lights, and other equipment on the new police vehicles;

WHEREAS, in regard to the provision of lights, sirens and similar equipment for the new police vehicles and police service aide vehicles, Signal Technologies Enterprises, Inc. has an existing contract with the City of Miami that was competitively procured under Bid No. 270252(16), entitled "Purchase and/or Installation of Additional Emergency Vehicle Equipment – Citywide," and awarded pursuant to City of Miami Resolution No. 12-0033;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-322 of the City Code, City staff respectfully requests that the City Council adopt the existing agreement between Signal Technologies Enterprises, Inc. and the City Of Miami, which was competitively entered into in a manner similar to that set forth in Chapter 2, Article V, of the City Code for the installation of lights, sirens and other equipment on 14 new police vehicles in an

amount not to exceed \$55,566.00, and further requests that the City Council authorize the City Manager to expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City with respect to the agreement approved herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Doral Florida authorizes the adoption of the existing agreement between Signal Technologies Enterprises, Inc. and the City Of Miami, which was competitively entered into in a manner similar to that set forth in Chapter 2, Article V, of the City Code for the installation of lights, sirens and other equipment on 14 new police vehicles in an amount not to exceed \$55,566.00.

Section 2. The City Council further authorizes the City Manager to expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City with respect to the agreement approved herein.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
