A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AWARDING INVITATION TO BID 2015-40. "NW 109 AVENUE (41-50)STREET) **ROADWAY** CONSTRUCTION," TO METRO EXPRESS, INC., THE LOWEST, MOST RESPONSIVE AND RESPONSIBLE BIDDER; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT, SUBJECT TO APPROVAL BY THE CITY ATTORNEY AS TO FORM AND LEGAL SUFFICIENCY, WITH METRO EXPRESS, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$436,542.48 FOR THE ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS ON NW 109 AVENUE BETWEEN NW 41 STREET AND NW 50 STREET AND EXPEND BUDGETED **FUNDS FURTHERANCE** HEREOF; **PROVIDING** IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in response to Invitation to Bid #2015-40 (the "ITB") for "NW 109 Avenue Roadway Construction from NW 41 Street to NW 50 Street" (the "Project"), the City of Doral (the "City") received nine (9) bids by the December 16, 2015 deadline with all nine (9) companies meeting the required criteria; and

WHEREAS, upon review of bids received, staff determined that Metro Express, Inc. was the lowest most responsive and responsible bidder (the "Contractor"); and

WHEREAS, a copy of Contractor's Bid Submittal, along with the Construction Contract, ITB #2015-40 Inventory, and Bid Tabulation are all attached hereto as Composive Exhibit A and included herein and made a part hereof by this reference; and

WHEREAS, staff has recommended that the Mayor and City Council award the ITB to the Contractor, and authorize the Manager to enter into a contract for the Project with the Contractor in a not to exceed amount of \$436,542.48, which includes a 10% contingency for any unforeseen conditions, and to expend budgeted funds in furtherance hereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made part hereof by this reference.

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Award.</u> The ITB for construction of the Project is awarded to Metro Express, Inc., subject to the entering into an agreement with the City on the same or substantially similar terms as presented in Contractor's bid. The award of the ITB does not, in and of itself, constitute a vested contractual right to Contractor.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Authorization.</u> The City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute such agreement and other contractual documents, subject to approval by the City Attorney as to form and legal sufficiency, as may be necessary to retain Contractor for the construction of the project, in and for an amount of \$436,542.48 (which includes a 10% contingency for any unforeseen conditions), and to expend budgeted funds in furtherance hereof.

Section 4. Implementation. The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and the provisions of this Resolution.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
