A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-323 OF THE CITY CODE, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXPEND FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE AND SHIPMENT OF AN EMERGENCY RESPONSE TRAILER WITH PLASTIC BARRIERS FROM YODOCK WALL COMPANY AS A SOLE SOURCE PROVIDER, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$18,132.99 OF WHICH \$16,010.00 WERE AWARDED TO THE CITY OF DORAL AS PART OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2012 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JAG – LOCAL SOLICITATION GRANT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral is the recipient of the FY12 Edward Byrne Memorial JAG – Local Solicitation Grant in the amount of \$16,010I.00; and

WHEREAS, these funds are intended for the purchase of an emergency response trailer with plastic barriers; and

WHEREAS, Staff has received a quote from the Yodock Wall Company, a registered vendor with the City of Doral, as well as a sole source provider of the emergency response trailer with barriers, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-323 of the City Code, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize the City Manager to expend funds for the purchase and shipment of an emergency trailer with plastic barriers from Yodock Wall Company as a sole source provider, in an amount not to exceed \$18,132.00 of which \$16,010.00 were awarded to the City as part of the FY12 Edward Byrne Memorial JAG – Local Solicitation Grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Council of the City of Doral hereby Council authorizes the City Manager to authorize the City Manager to expend funds for the purchase and shipment of an emergency trailer with plastic barriers from Yodock Wall Company as a sole source provider, in an amount not to exceed \$18,132.00 of which \$16,010.00 were awarded to the City as part of the FY12 Edward Byrne Memorial JAG – Local Solicitation Grant.
