## RESOLUTION NO. 2008-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AMENDING RESOLUTION 2007-22 TO CONTINUE TO EXPRESS THE CITY'S DESIRE TO LEASE OR PURCHASE 6.45 ACRES OR MORE, IF AVAILABLE AND CONTIGUOUS, OF PROPERTY FROM THE STATE OF FLORIDA; FURTHER EXPRESSING ITS DESIRE TO USE THIS PROPERTY FOR A POLICE FACLITY OR SIMILAR GOVERNMENTAL PURPOSE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on April 23, 2007, the City Council adopted Resolution 2007-22 which expressed its desire to lease or purchase 6.45 acres of property from the State of Florida for park or recreational purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City now desires to lease or purchase that property for a police facility or similar governmental purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Doral hereby find that it is in the best interests of the City to lease/purchase 6.45 acres more, if available and contiguous, from the State of Florida; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

Section 2. The Mayor and City Council of the City of Doral hereby authorize the City Manager or his designee to negotiate with the State of Florida for the lease/purchase of the 6.45 acres or more, if available and contiguous, to be used for a police facility or similar governmental purpose.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective upon its passage and adoption by the City Council.
