RESOLUTION NO. 2004-83

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL ESTABLISHING A PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE OF \$2.447 TO BALANCE THE GENERAL FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2004-2005; ESTABLISHING THE ROLLED-BACK RATE TO BE -0-; AND ESTABLISHING WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 22, 2004 AS THE DATE THAT A FINAL PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD AT 6:30 P.M. AT THE FIRE RESCUE HEADQUARTERS, 9300 NW 41ST STREET, DORAL, FLORIDA 33178; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Doral establishes, pursuant to State law, a proposed millage rate to balance the budget for the General Fund for Fiscal Year 2004-2005; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of State law the City has confirmed its rolled-back rate and established a time and place for a public hearing on the City's proposed millage rate and budget; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That the City Council establishes a proposed millage rate of \$2.447 to balance the budget for the General Fund for Fiscal Year 2004-2005 and establishes Wednesday, September 22, 2004 at 6:30pm, as the date and time of a final public hearing when the City Council will receive comments from the citizenry regarding the proposed budget and proposed millage rate.

Section 2. That the City Council further confirms the rolled-back rate for the 2004-2005 fiscal year to be -0-.

Section 3. That the City Council further establishes the place and time of said public hearing to be the Fire Rescue Headquarters, located at 9300 NW 41st Street, Doral, Florida 33178 at 6:30 P.M..

Section 4. Effective Date.

This resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
