A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH MIAMI-DADE COUNTY FOR CANAL MAINTENANCE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City will be required to enter into an interlocal agreement with Miami-Dade County as soon as the transfer of the Stormwater Utility is finalized; and

WHEREAS, once the Stormwater Utility is transferred, the City will be responsible for the maintenance of all canals and their embankment; and

WHEREAS, the County will retain ownership of the canals.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section I. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute an Interlocal Agreement for with Miami-Dade County for canal maintenance

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
