RESOLUTION NO. 03-15

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO NEGOTIATE AN INITIAL INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR CONTINUING SERVICES WITH MIAMI-DADE COUNTY; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AFTER APPROVAL BY THE CITY COUNCIL; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, as a newly incorporated municipality, the City of Doral (the "City") is unable to provide all of the required municipal services, such as fire rescue and solid waste, to its residents; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County (the "County") has been providing these services to the City's residents prior to incorporation and continues to provide them.

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is in the best interests of the City to enter into an interlocal agreement with the County so that the County continues to provide services to the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.
- Section 2. Authorization to Negotiate. The Mayor, City Manager and City Attorney are authorized to negotiate an Interlocal Agreement between Miami-Dade County and the City of Doral to continue receiving municipal services from the County.
- <u>Section 3.</u> <u>Execution of Agreement.</u> The Mayor is authorized to execute this Interlocal Agreement once it has been approved by the City Council.
- Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
