WHEREAS, Article IV, Section 4.01(b) of the City of Doral (the "City") Charter authorizes the City Council to determine its own rules of procedure; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires that questions of procedure be governed by Robert's Rules of Order.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Adoption of Rules. Robert's Rules of Order are hereby adopted as the City of Doral's temporary standard of parliamentary procedure, and questions of procedure shall be governed by application of the rules.

Section 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
