A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-321 OF THE CITY'S CODE OF ORDINANCES, APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF ONE TI TRAINING LAB IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$146,655.00 FROM TI TRAINING CORP., A SOLE SOURCE VENDOR; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT, SUBJECT TO APPROVAL AS TO FORM AND LEGAL SUFFICIENCY BY THE CITY ATTORNEY FOR THE PURCHASE; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral Police Department requests to purchase one Ti

Training Lab; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department restfully requests to purchase one Ti Training Lab from Ti Training Corp., a sole source vendor. This system is the industry-leading law enforcement simulation technology, and it provides for a wide range of use. These options include firearms and less-lethal devices at our disposal. The system features 800 preloaded, unique scenarios in many different categories. In addition, it has the ability for our training department to create and customize scenarios to fit our needs. The Ti Training Lab allows the police department to conduct impactful use-of-force training for our personnel. It can increase the Doral residents' awareness of our officers' decision-making process when faced with a use of force situation; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 2-321 of the City Code, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Ti Training Corp., a sole source vendor for the purchase of one Ti Training Lab in an amount equal to \$146,655.00, and further requests that the City Council authorize the City Manager to expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City with respect to the

agreement approved herein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Approval. Pursuant to section 2-321, the purchase of one Ti Training Lab from Ti Training Corp., as a sole source vendor. These funds are deemed by the Police Department for appropriate use according to the permissible use stated in the Law Enforcement Trust Fund guide by the Department of Justice and Treasury. The funds will be allocated from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund (LETF) Capital Outlay Office, #105.60005.500640- (Local \$73,327.50, Treasury- \$51,329.25, and Justice-\$21,998.25) for a total not to exceed the amount of \$146,655.00.

Section 3. Authorization: The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement and other contractual documents, subject to approval as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney, as may be necessary to procure the training lab under the sole source letter provided by Ti Training Corp. to expend funds in furtherance thereof in amounts not to exceed \$146,655.00.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Implementation.</u> The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and provisions of this Resolution.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
