RESOLUTION NO. 04-43

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURE FOR THE PRESENTATION OF PROCLAMATIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, from time to time, there are groups, organizations and individuals worthy of recognition for significant accomplishments; and

WHEREAS, municipal governments have traditionally recognized such significant accomplishments with the issuance of proclamations; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.02(v) of the Municipal Charter of the City of Doral recognizes the Mayor as head of the City government for all ceremonial purposes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

- <u>Section 1</u>. The Mayor is hereby authorized to present proclamations, on behalf of the City, recognizing groups, organizations or individuals for significant accomplishments.
- <u>Section 2.</u> The City Clerk shall provide notice to the City Council of all proclamations issued by the Mayor.
- Section 3. The City Council, by majority vote, may rescind proclamations issued by the Mayor at its next regularly scheduled meeting following the presentation of the proclamation.
 - Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
