To Whom It May Concern:

In December 2014, the City Council adopted a new ordinance that mandates that multifamily residences implement a single-stream recycling program by July 1, 2015. This ordinance applies to multifamily communities that have 4 or more dwelling units and are not currently receiving recycling services from Miami-Dade County.

During the next seven months, the City will be conducting a public education and outreach campaign to inform residents and Home Owners Association's (HOA's) of these new requirements. During the months July - September 2015, our staff will begin issuing "Warning Notices" to properties found not to be in compliance with the City of Doral's Code.

Beginning in October 2015, our staff will begin enforcing the multifamily recycling ordinance. Additional costs associated with adding recycling services can often be offset by reducing the size of your solid waste container and/or the frequency of solid waste disposal. Please contact your licensed waste hauler to set up a single-stream recycling program that meets the needs of your property.

The goal of this new ordinance is to decrease the percentage of waste that is sent to landfills. The City is committed to sustainable initiatives that improve the overall health of the environment. Thank you in advance for your cooperation and we look forward to working with your community.
